With the lack of available green space for additional sporting facilities in many metropolitan regions, Narre Warren South P-12 College and the City of Casey engaged in a joint use agreement to benefit both the school and the local community.

Ausco provided the 325m<sup>2</sup> facility which includes classrooms, four changerooms and toilet facilities, as well as a kiosk, first aid and cleaner rooms, and a storage space. Site works took only 5 weeks, reducing the impact on the College's usual activities.

An important design feature of the modular facilities stipulated by the stakeholders was the need to elevate the building to maximise the viewing capabilities from the external deck, which Ausco's in-house design team were able to accommodate. The changeroom facility also includes sound-rated operable walls that allow the space to be used in several different ways pending the various user needs.

The project has received praise from the local MP and government representatives as an example of a successful community collaboration to be replicated across Victoria.
