Following the development of a new oval at RMIT University's Bundoora West campus, Ausco Modular delivered purpose-built, inclusive player changerooms and supporting amenities. The new facilities enabled the return of the university's largest sporting clubs to the Bundoora Sports Precinct and supported the growth of women's football within the local community.

The facility comprises two unisex, fully compliant changerooms featuring private cubicle showers, two medical rooms, an AFL-standard umpires' facility, public amenities, a storage area, and the university's first gender-neutral toilet within a sporting environment. Each changeroom is also equipped with 30 digital lockers, ensuring secure storage of personal belongings for players and coaching staff.

An independent assessment comparing modular construction with traditional on-site building methods confirmed that modular delivery achieved efficiencies of up to 60% faster completion times and cost savings of between 15 and 30%.

With ongoing support from the Essendon Football Club, the establishment of the Women's Football Academy will provide education and development pathways for students and elite athletes, while promoting increased participation and long-term growth in women's football.
