Never walk under a suspended load.

RISK

Falling objects and buildings can increase the risk of people being crushed by falling or moving objects.

WHERE THIS RISK MAY APPLY TO YOU:

- A suspended load during lifting, loading or unloading of buildings or equipment;
- Working below other work areas where others are working above you;
- When working underneath a building undertaking preparation work;
- > Working in storage areas where equipment is being stored;
- When moving buildings with forklifts or cranes, and travel paths may move over workers below.

PERSONAL BEHAVIOURS

- I can use the correctly engineered equipment including props and stands.
- I can make sure that drivers remain in the 'safe zone' by educating them about the risks to themselves.
- I can 'stop the job' if unauthorised people move into an 'no-go' zones.
- I can make sure I have good visual contact & communication with mobile equipment operators before approaching mobile equipment.
- I can make sure I know the 'blind spots' around large mobile equipment.
- I can make sure loads are stable on forklifts & secure on trucks before movement / transport.
- > Make sure correct load restraint is undertaken.
- I can make sure I never lift loads over the top of workers by checking travel paths are clear.
