

LSR 5

Always obey road rules, drive to conditions, follow your journey plan.

RISK

Speeding, not following road rules or not driving to conditions increases the risk of losing control of your vehicle.

WHERE THIS RISK MAY APPLY TO YOU:

- Driving beyond the posted speed limit;
- Driving and not following recommended road caution signs;
- Driving long distances without taking adequate rest breaks or without having a journey plan;
- > Not driving to the prevailing conditions (wet weather, low visibility, heavy traffic.
- Not following road rules (e.g. using a hand held mobile phone when driving, not wearing my seatbelt).

PERSONAL BEHAVIOURS

- I can follow the speed limit posted and adjust my speed as needed.
- > I can be attentive when driving and observe the all relevant caution signs on my journey.
- I can complete journey plans for trips more than 2 hours in duration or in remote locations
- > I can adjust my driving behaviour to help manage the prevailing conditions when driving.
