## RISK

Continuing to work in an unsafe situation and not speaking up could cause multiple fatalities or permanent injuries to work mates.

## WHERE THIS RISK MAY APPLY TO YOU:

- > Client or operational pressure to get the job done without question;
- > Continuing on without redoing your Risk Assessment Activity when something changes;
- > The controls are not good enough or someone is not following them;
- > If equipment is faulty or shortcuts are being considered;
- > When things don't look right when doing a job.

## PERSONAL BEHAVIOURS

- > I can be thorough when I complete my Risk Assessments
- > I can stop the job if I think it is unsafe and it just doesn't seem right.
- > I will speak up – it could save my life or one of my workmates.
- > I will encourage all workers to speak up if they think something is unsafe or people are at risk.
- > I will support those that do speak up, regardless of their position within the business.
- > I will be thankful if someone stops my job if they think I am at risk of injury.
